

Lady of the Lake II – Food Service Personnel

Positions: 2 employees May 1 – October 15
2 employees June 1 – September 20

Pay rate is \$9.00 per hour with a .50 cent per hour bonus if you stay through the term that you agree to when hired. **If you stay as agreed your pay rate is equivalent to \$9.50 per hour.**

The Food Service Area on the Lady of the Lake II provides snack bar service for travelers on the Boat. Currently, this consists primarily of snack food items, microwave sandwiches, hot dogs and smoothies. This person also collects tickets from passengers at stops and will record tickets collected as instructed.

This is a brief description of the job duties:

1. Work 3 or 4, ten-hour days per week. Please state your preference on your application. Each employee will work either Saturday or Sunday. In some cases you may be asked to work both days. The shifts are from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. (+).
2. You must be dependable. Absenteeism or tardiness is not acceptable. When the boat departs, all supplies must be on and personnel in place.
3. You must have a valid Food Handler's Permit and a valid Class 12 Alcohol Server's Permit. We can assist you in signing up for the Alcohol Server's Permit Class if you do not have that permit.
4. You must be able to handle freight and assist in loading freight in Chelan and at all stops along the lake. This can be very strenuous and each piece, on average, weighs 20 to 50 lbs. Please state on your application if you have any type of physical limitation that would keep you from performing this duty (such as a bad back, knee, arms, etc.). You will also be in charge of tying and untying the stern of the vessel at landings.
5. You must be able to operate a cash register and give correct change. You must be able to follow instructions for ringing up transactions and closing the till at the end of a shift.
6. You must be able to follow instructions on food preparation, portion sizes and follow all duties involving the upkeep and cleaning of the food service and related areas.
7. You must keep a clean appearance and follow the dress code. Any dark colored pant or knee length shorts are acceptable. Uniform shirts will be provided to you.
8. This is a high public contact area. You must enjoy this type of contact and be receptive to questions and answers to situations that it presents.
9. You will have an unpaid lunch break in Stehekin during the layover. Upon arrival in Stehekin you will assist in the off loading of freight, take your lunch break and then assist with the loading of freight for the down lake passengers.
